The resources of this Establishment will enable the Directors to execute the Work with the utmost despatch, and they will be glad to commence the same as soon as the requisite preliminaries are adjusted.

The Directors would undertake to complete the Shaft in three months from receipt of order. I am, however, desirous to add, that the Shaft must be taken as it comes from the Forge, they also stipulate that any question of blemish is to be settled by arbitration.
